

Documentary Film Production Minor

The Minor in Documentary Film Production combines hands-on and conceptual aspects of documentary film production. The minor is designed for students coming from a range of disciplines to serve their interest in media content production, with emphasis in documentary film/video production.

Students who want to minor in documentary film production should declare the minor online. You must have at least a 2.00 UO GPA to apply to the minor. SOJC majors pursuing this minor may overlap one "JCOM" course between the major and minor. Jour: Media Studies (JMS) majors pursuing the documentary studies major track should discuss implications of this restriction with their SOJC advisor.
